Town Business:

Grant was approved for \$8,200 for fire signs with matching funds. We cannot use labor as part of our matching funds.

Old signs will be put up by buildings when replaced with new signs.

Supplemental Aid was sent out for 2024 and 2025.

Big Hook schedule was discussed and they have contacted us stating it will not be extending our contract. Also discussed raising prices for collection of items brought to the recycle center. When prices are decided we will need to print new information and post at the recycle center and on the website.

Town Road

Patrolmen reported culverts needs to be replaced at Stellner Rd and North Ridge. Stellner will need 2 culverts and graveled this to get ready for seal coat next year. North Ridge needs 6 culverts. Roads that need to be graveled are Ames, Sordahl, Stellner, Sorenson and Hansen Ln. Motion made and seconded by Keith/Kent to approve the culverts, gravel and work to be done on the roads. Motion carried.

Registered Letter to Rick Petruska to remove vehicles from road right away within 10 days of receiving letter. And if not removed, township will remove at owners expense.

We received 3 bids for a new waste oil furnace. Bids were received from HCS for \$10,000, DSI for \$12,000 and Black Gold for \$10,894. Motion was made and seconded by Keith/Lorn to accept bid for Black Gold for \$10,894. Motion carried. Bid signed and Clerk to send to Black Gold.

Fahner bid was received. Motion was made and seconded by Kent/Keith to do Dudley, King Hill, Coleman and Volden Ln. with clarification on Dudley. Wire Hollow to be done next year. Motion carried.

Dudley Hill funds were discussed and it will have to be reposted in the paper for bids. Working with Phil at County.

Accounts Payable


Motion made and seconded by Kent/Keith to approve the bills to be paid. Motion carried.
