

# Town of Harmony July Monthly Board Meeting/Minutes

Pledge of Allegiance was stated

**Town Business:** Discussed contacting Nelson's to see if we can have an in-store account to free up credit card limit.

Bid on 2002 International Straight Truck from Town of Genoa for \$12,100 was accepted. Motion made by Bauer/Gartner to execute bid and issue check for \$12,100 to Town of Genoa. Motion passed.

Discussed putting bids in paper for 1997 IH 4800 dump truck with 11" plow and 12' sander and IH DT 466 engine. Clerk to put bids in paper and have sealed bids returned to clerk and accept until Sept 17<sup>th</sup> meeting when they will be opened. Discussed purchasing new lawn mower. Keith had bids from Nelson Agri-Center for Simplicity Conquest, 52" for \$5,650 and a Farris zero turn for \$7,700. Loren has prices from John Deere. Patrolmen and Charlie to go to John Deere and look at them on Friday. Motion made by Goede/Gartner and seconded to purchase from John Deere up to \$7,000 with possible financing. Motion passed. Keith upstained.

**Town Roads:** Patrolmen to check Wyman property on Kuester Lane by shed for damage.

Road not to be seal coated are Kuester Lane and Mendiola Lane. Hass, Upper Newton and Wing Hollow will be done. There has been no contact from anyone about the bridge or dip.

**Zoning Report:** Meeting held July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020 with Pete Strachan, Jim Theler, Emery Weaver and Soterios Lallas by phone. Rezoning was presented to rezone property From Emery Weaver to Jerry Miller. Motion made to approve rezone by Goede/Bauer. Motion passed.

Dan Weaver talked to neighbors. Pete will talk to Dan about rezone. No animal by product dumping

Discussed no animal by product

**Election Report:** Suzanne Harris presented election information for the August 11, 2020 election. Discussed Covid-19 and the safety and concerns. Voting will be held in the town hall. We applied for a grant from WES Cares and was approved in the amount of \$627. Motion made and seconded by Goede/Bauer to use the grant funds for election supplies due to COVID-19. Funds will be used to purchase plexiglass for the tables, shields for workers and masks, gloves and sanitizers for all that need. Posting signs advising Town Board would appreciate all to wear masks and No Guns Policy with posting at doors.
