


This is a meeting for landowners in the Towns of Genoa and Wheatland with an existing 161 kV line on their property and who stand to be directly impacted by the proposed Maribell 765 kV transmission line. It is also for town board members and for people interested in helping to organize similar meetings with directly impacted landowners in their communities.

The presentation will start at 11am. After a very short overview, we will begin Q&A.

Assisting with discussion will be Rob Danielson, a potentially impacted landowner in the Town of Stark, Vernon County. Rob has been a student of utility expansion planning since 2011 and an intervenor in the Badger-Coulee and Cardinal Hickory Creek 345 kV expansion transmission line proposals.

Our current 161 kV lines are 70ft tall (about as tall as average trees)

The easements for 161 kV lines are currently 80-100ft.

The new 765 kV towers are 200ft tall and easements are 200-250ft.
